CHAPERONES

During performances of Aladdin Jr., children will be supervised and supported by trained and licenced chaperones. We are seeking parents or carers willing to take on this role. This will involve attending two training sessions run by Surrey County Council in the run up to the event, and being willing to undergo an Enhanced DBS Check, the fee for which will be paid for by G Live.

Chaperones will be asked to commit to a minimum of 8-hours over the course of the summer youth project and will receive complimentary tickets to a performance of Aladdin. Please note that you are unable to apply to be a licenced chaperone if you have any criminal convictions.

The **two-week summer project**, taking place between 25 July – 6 August 2022 **provides young performers aged 8-18 years old the chance to tread the boards** at a venue that's hosted the biggest stars in show business, with **FOUR full-scale performances** with the help of a professional creative team.

AUDITIONS

The Audition date for Disney's Aladdin JR is **Saturday 23 April 2022 at 10am at G Live, Guildford**. Full information regarding times will be available closer to the time. Auditionees will need to wear comfortable clothes that you can dance in, bring plenty to drink, and a packed lunch if you are invited to return for principal auditions in the afternoon.

Please note.

You must be over 14 years of age to be considered for a principal part. Only the auditionee will be allowed into the auditorium. Responsible adults will need to remain in the foyer areas.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

The Summer Youth Project is open to young people aged 8-18 years, on or before 6 August 2022 only.

We anticipate that auditions will be popular and due to the actual number of Project places available and time restrictions on audition day we may not be able to see anyone who misses the application form deadline or just turns up on the day. AUDITION DAY: SATURDAY 23 APRIL 2022

All applicants who have submitted a form will be invited to audition. The auditions will be held on Saturday 23 April at G Live, Guildford. We will put more details of timings, what you have to prepare etc. on our website and via email nearer the time. There is no charge for the audition, and no previous experience is necessary.

Please wear comfortable clothes (no jeans) and suitable footwear and be prepared to sing and dance! You should also bring a packed lunch, plenty to drink and a book or something to do as there can be quite a bit of waiting around as we try to see everyone.

Callbacks for Principal roles will be announced on the day for later that afternoon. If you/your child are/is chosen as a Principal for Disney's Aladdin Jr there may be some rehearsals prior to Project that you/they will

need to attend – these will be scheduled in the week prior to the start of SYP. These dates will be confirmed nearer the time.

Final casting selections will be made later in the day when all auditionees have left. You will then be notified by email whether you have been successful or not. Confirmation packs to all successful auditionees will be posted shortly after.

Please note: Only people auditioning will be allowed into the auditorium. Our Café will be open for parents / friends to wait.

AVAILABILITY

Due to the short production and rehearsal time for this show, all participants must be available for **ALL** dates between 25-30 July and 1-6 August 2022. All participants must be fully committed to the show during this period.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals will start at 10am and continue until 5pm with a break for lunch (and a dinner break when evening rehearsals are required). Towards the end of the rehearsal process, the days will be longer, however all call times will be in line with Surrey County Council guidelines for child performers. Full information regarding rehearsal timing will follow at a later date.

PERFORMANCES

Performances will take place on Thursday 4, Friday 5 and Saturday 6 August. There will be evening performances and one matinee showing, with tickets going on sale in April 2022.

FEES

If you are offered a place, **the fee for this year's Summer Youth Project is £300**. This covers **twelve days** of rehearsals and performances between 25 July – 6 August 2022. The fee does not involve transport or meals, and you might be asked to bring in basic items of costume eg. shoes (this will only be items you will already have at home).

We have an instalment payment schedule in place, meaning you can split the payment of fees over 3 months. For more information, email fmoon@glive.co.uk

CHAPERONES

Rehearsals will be suitably staffed and supervised by professionals trained in safeguarding, who will all hold an Enhanced DBS Check. All performances will also be staffed by trained, licenced chaperones. If you would be willing to undergo training to become a licenced chaperone, please contact fmoon@glive.co.uk. Chaperones are asked to commit to a minimum of two shifts and will receive free tickets to one of the Aladdin performances.
